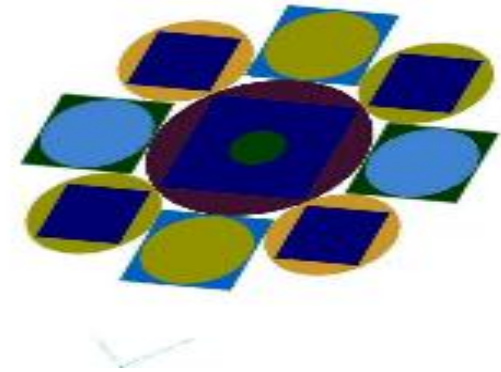

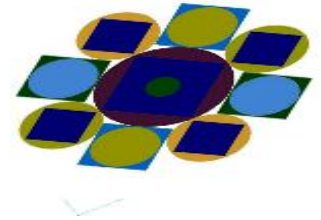

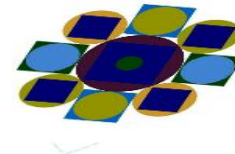

# Basotho Embrace Regionalism

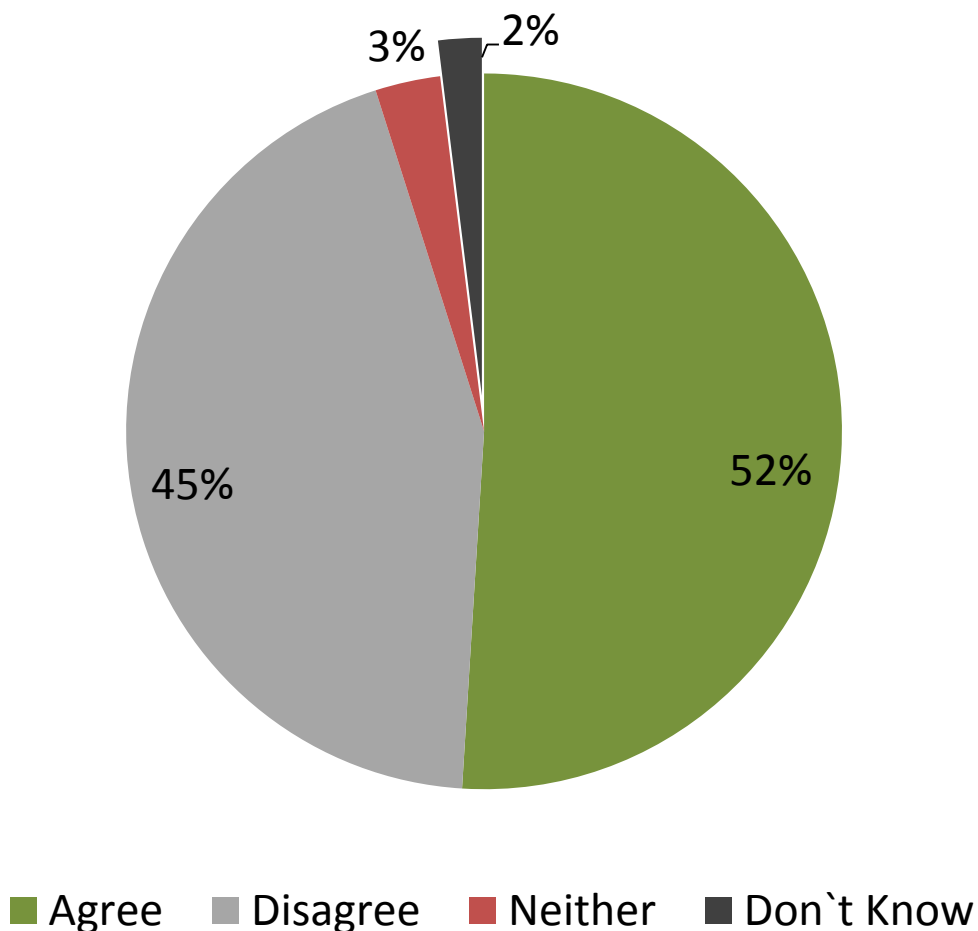


- A majority of Basotho support regionalism for improving trade and job creation and managing conflicts
- South Africa is the country's major trade and job partner, and Basotho believe that relationship is key to meaningful development in Lesotho

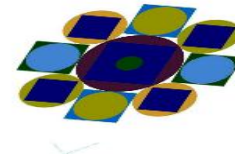

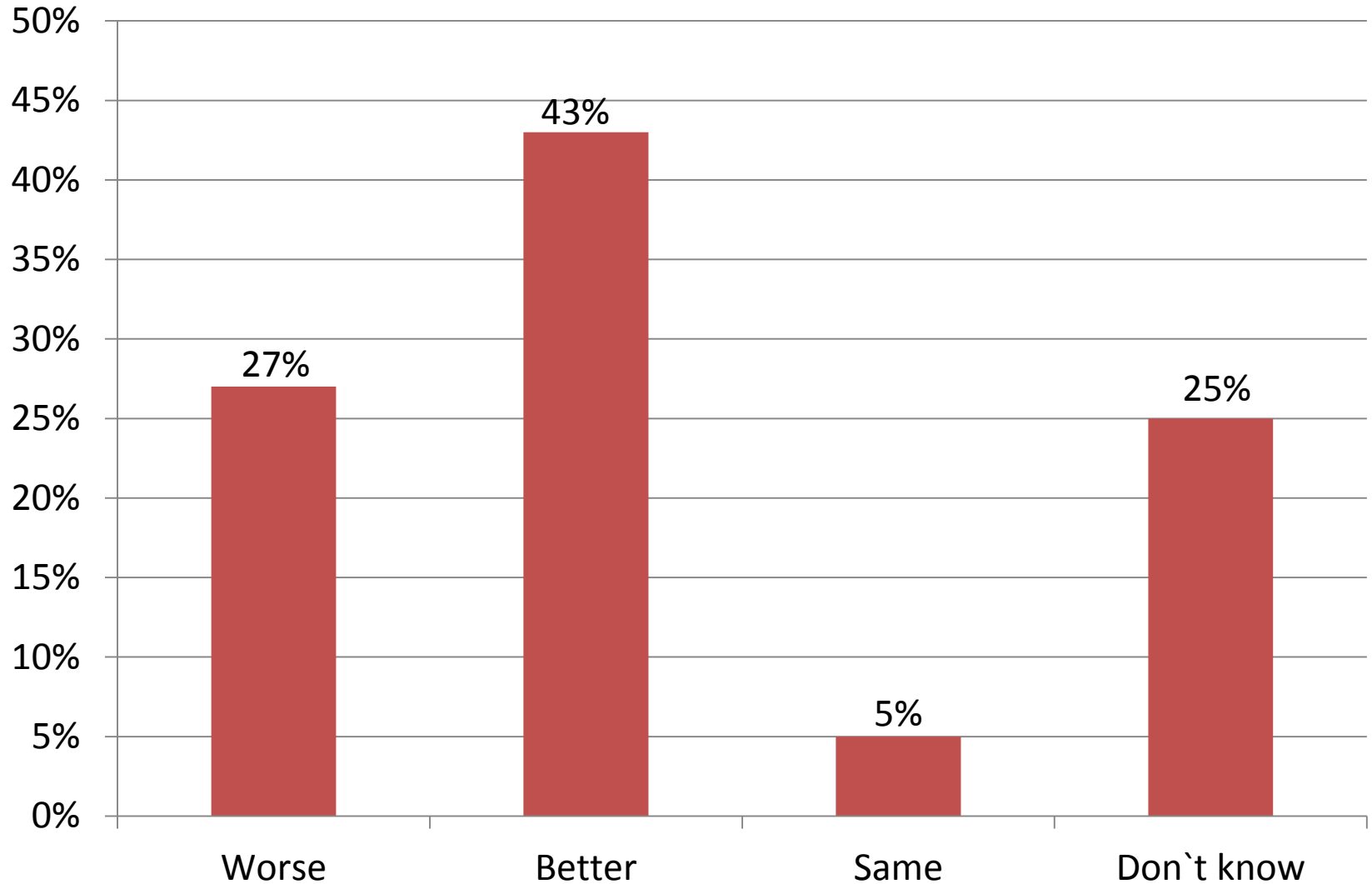
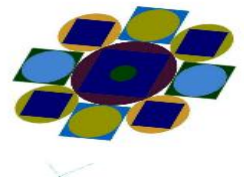


Does implementation of the protocol make the availability of jobs, markets and trading opportunities better or worse?

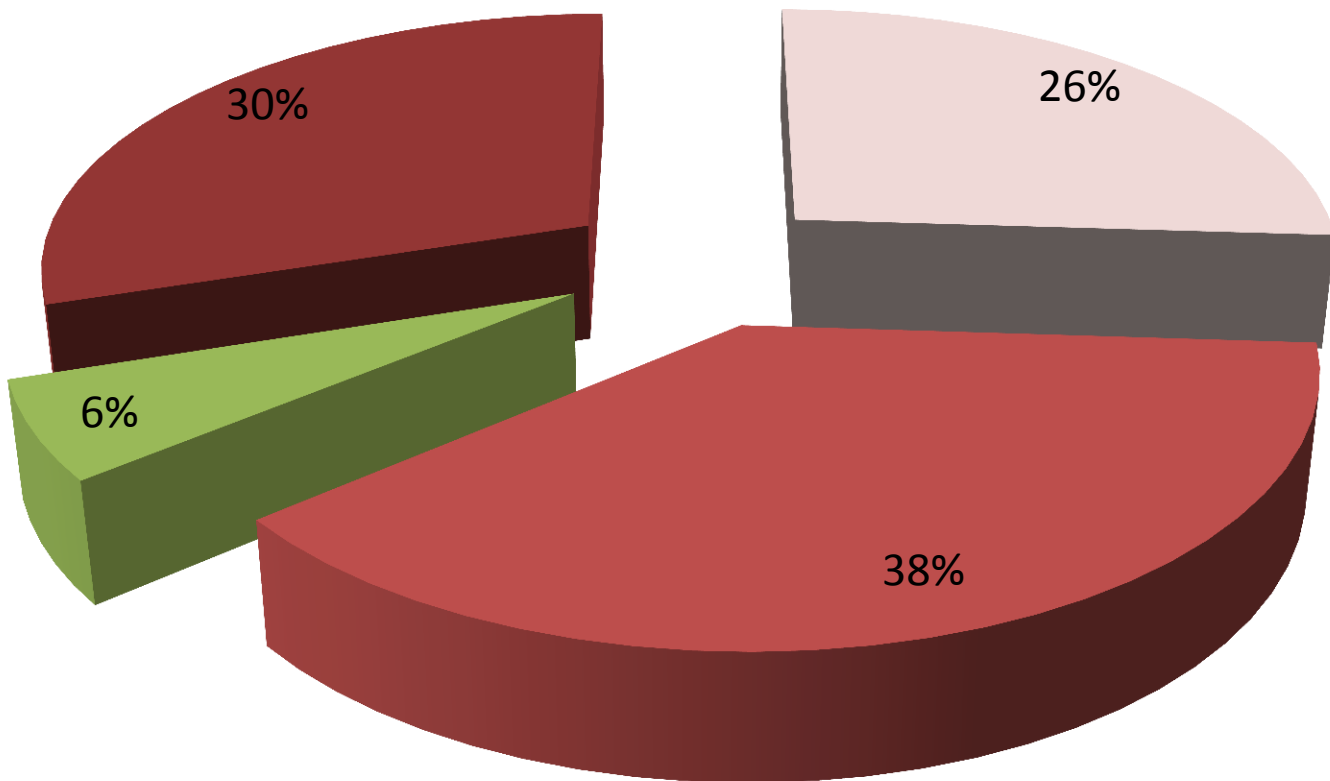
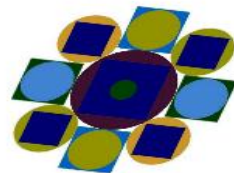


# SADC Protocol and Stabilising of Prices



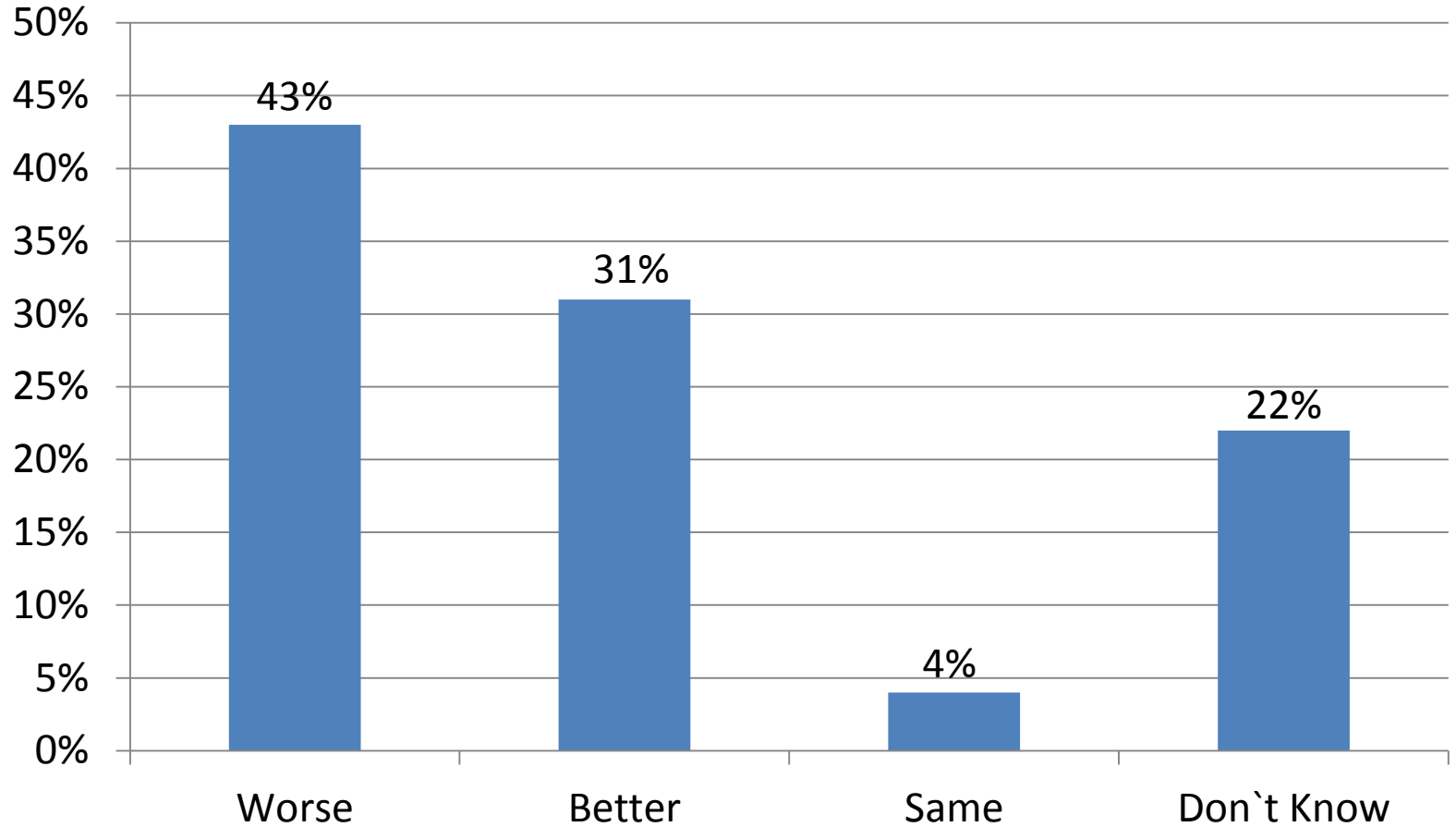
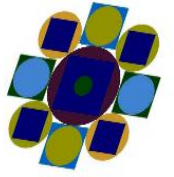


# SADC Protocol and Strengthening of Democracy

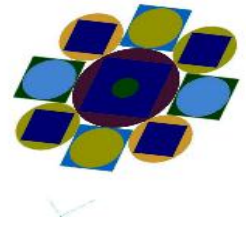

# Key Findings
