**Afrobarometer Round 4, 2009**

<b>Dates of Fieldwork:</b>	9 to 23 May 2009
<b>Sample size:</b>	1200
<b>Sampling frame:</b>	2008 projected population provided by Central Statistical Office (CSO) based on 2002 Census
<b>Sample universe:</b>	Citizens age 18 years or older, excluding institutions
<b>Sample design:</b>	Nationally representative, random, clustered, stratified, multistage, probability sample design.
<b>Stratification:</b>	Province and urban-rural distribution
<b>Stages:</b>	SSUs (District, rural areas only), PSUs (EAs), starting points, households and respondents
<b>SSU/PSU selection:</b>	Probability Proportionate to Population Size (PPPS)
<b>Cluster size:</b>	Two PSUs per SSU (rural only), 8 households per PSU
<b>Household selection:</b>	Randomly selected start points, followed by walk pattern using 5/10 interval.
<b>Respondent selection:</b>	Gender quota filled by alternating interviews between males and females. Using respondents of appropriate gender listed, after which household member draws a numbered card to select individual.
<b>Weighting:</b>	Weighted to account for individual selection probabilities.
<b>Margin of error:</b>	+/- 3% with 95% confidence level
<b>Fieldwork by:</b>	Mass Public Opinion Institute (MPOI)
<b>Survey Languages:</b>	Shona, Ndebele and English
<b>Main Researcher:</b>	Prof. Eldred Masunungure, Anyway Ndapwadza
<b>Outcome rates:</b>	Contact rate: 0.948 Cooperation rate: 0.746 Refusal rate: 0.090 Response rate: 0.707
